

Rules and regulations for fishing.

- Carnivore fishing :

(Pike and blackbait) no kill, catch and release is compulsory for all sizes.



Fishing techniques strictly forbidden : Live fishing (live fish). Fishing with dead fish and dead fish handled. Drop shot fishing. Trolling.

Authorised fishing techniques : Casting with artificial lures or spoons. Pole or line fishing. Fly fishing.



<u>The use of steel, large-diameter fluorocarbon or titanium leaders is compulsory, as is</u> <u>the use of barbless hooks.</u>

The use of tools that make it easier to unhook fish, such as landing nets, pliers or gags, is strongly recommended.

- White fishing :

Cork fishing or English fishing. (Rotengles, chevennes, tanches, goujons, sun perch, etc....) Be equipped with a disgorger. It is forbidden to keep your catch.

- Opening and closing times :

Fishing is closed during the months of December, January and February. may be brought forward or extended depending on the state of the lake. As the lake is used as a reservoir for agricultural purposes, fishing may be stopped if the water level becomes critical, resulting in a lack of oxygen and high temperatures.

The following rules must be observed :

Do not fish or sail in the ± 30m zone all along the campsite, the snack bar and the park marked with buoys.

It is strictly <u>forbidden to use combustion engines on the lake</u>, only electric motors are permitted.

Night fishing is prohibited and is considered to be poaching. It is strictly forbidden to fish for grass carp, crayfish and freshwater mussels in the lake.

A fishing licence for the lake must be obtained from the bar and is compulsory. Checks may be carried out at any time during the day.

If you fail to comply with these rules, your right to fish on the lake may be withdrawn.

The management.
